Thank you for your support and I hope your child enjoys their swimming lessons.

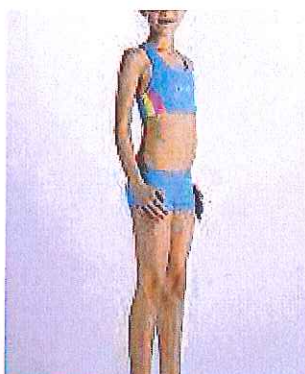
