HELPING AT HOME

School crams as much as possible into the school day however there is much you can do at home to help and support your child's learning. Research shows that when school and home work together and children are supported in their learning at home , they do better academically than those children who solely rely on school.

Reading

Please hear you child read from their reading book at least three times a week. In addition to this read a story from a reading from pleasure book to your child daily.

Spelling

Your child will be set spellings to learn each week and will be tested the following week. Please ensure that your child learns these. The interactive website 'Spelling Shed' has your child's spellings featured and allows them to be learnt and tested at home using any web based device. Practice with them and test them so they know how many they know before their spelling test.

Times Tables Rock tars

All year 6 children need to know need to know ALL of their times tables and corresponding division facts.
