Dear Parent/Carer of Children in Year 6

Weatherhead High School are kindly offering a free after school film club. Places are limited for this lovely opportunity for children who are particularly interested in making a short 'animated' film. The 'animated' film will be about loneliness and children will need some acting talent - for narrative and voice-overs. They will also require a level of patience and concentration. Some areas that will be covered include: story-telling, photography, 2D/3D art and design, sound design, title design, filming and sound recording techniques.

Sessions will be in Somerville on Tuesdays after school starting 29th January until 4.30pm, with the final session being on Tues 26th March. Children will need to be collected from the Key Stage 2 pupil entrance of school. There will also be an opportunity to see the screening of the film at Weatherhead on Thursday 4th July.

Children who participate in this usually see improvements in their ability to problemsolve, concentrate, work as a team, see tasks through to completion, develop communication and literacy skills, whilst gaining new creative skills with confidence.
