This follows a successful safeguarding audit which Mr Dickson commissioned last term to ensure that the safeguarding team were fully implementing their DSL roles and that all adults in school followed the Keeping Children Safe in Education document. Please see below some of the feedback given about school.

'Reflecting on the school motto, mission and values, these are clearly realised at the school in terms of safeguarding that the reviewer gleaned from staff. The children stated that they feel safe and that their views, concerns and feelings were listened to; if any of the pupils had any concerns or had been upset by fellow pupils, they were confident that the staff would listen and do something about it.'

The level of support for emotional and mental health, the staff development to understand about trauma, and how it effects children, are a credit to the school.
