Walk to school week 20th - 24th May

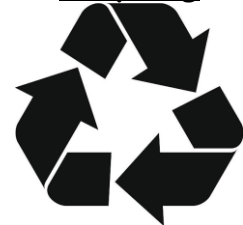


Walking all or part of the journey to and from nursery is an easy and effective way to help your child meet recommended daily activity levels.
