You can Apply for a School Uniform Grant of £150 per Child from 18th June 2024.

To apply for GroceryAid School Essentials Grant, you need to meet the following criteria:

- You've been working for a grocery employer for at least six months
- You're already receiving Universal Credit / Child Tax Credit for school-age children (aged 4-18 as of 31st August 2024)
- Your household savings/balances are less than £4,000
