#### ADVENTURE PLAYGROUND

The children came back to school to see that over the summer holidays extensive work had been carried out to create a new adventure playground. We wanted to make the play ground a space to run, play games and most of all have FUN! The previous playground was too small to allow our children the freedom of running around and have games and equipment out. The children also told us they would like more opportunities to climb. To make this possible for them we had to alter the layout by removing the fencing which was a real barrier to the quality of play available. With the removal of the fencing the children can run freely around all areas of the playground now and it has allowed us to install larger equipment frames for their use. 
# NAME TAGS
