ATTENDANCE UPDATE

Attendance and punctuality have both improved on the same period last year. This has made a real difference to the calmness of the school as there are less children coming in late disturbing lessons that have already started and becoming upset because they have been brought in late.

School being able to administer liquid paracetamol to make children comfortable during the school day with minor illness has made a real difference. Just to reassure parents that sometimes if a child has a cold or minor cough they may feel a bit rubbish when they wake up

however after they get going they generally pick up after 9.00am and present as fine in school. We would contact you if we felt your child needed to be at home with you.

Some families have hugely benefitted from family support workers who have helped the families with morning routines and behaviours.

Koala North West have supported families with sleep routines for those children who struggle to go to bed and sleep through the night meaning the child struggles to get up in the morning and come to school on time.

Our attendance team will continue to visit families who after day one of absence have not provided supporting evidence. They will also target those off on a Friday and Monday on regular occasions.

All children have the right to a full time education and to be in school for the full day. We will continue to advocate for those children with poor attendance and punctuality to ensure they get the education they are entitled to. CHRISTMAS DOORS


Teachers and TAs have been prepping for Christmas this week and creating their Christmas doors ready for next week to make the school feel as festive as possible for the Christmas period.

SENDCO SPOTLIGHT



To follow on from last week's newsletter about the Wirral's Tiered approach including Adaptive teaching, you will hopefully remember that Tier 4 stated that this is a "resources provision" for children with an EHCP. This is the smallest part of Wirral's pyramid which reflects the number of children who would benefit from this provision. Children MAY fall into Tier 4 if they

are 3 years below in 2 areas, and advice from other professionals has not been successful. An EHCP would be initiated by school AFTER we have evidence of working through each of the previous tiers. Parents can request an EHCP through The Wirral Education Authority but because of this strict criteria, we are seeing a number of parental requests being declined by them.
