<p>The school will do its best to:</p> <p>Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;</p> <p>Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;</p> <p>Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs as much as the current situation allows;</p> <p>Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;</p> <p>Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' have symptoms or test positive for COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days;</p> <p>Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;</p> <p>Communicate between home and school through notices, texts, email and the school website.</p>	<p>To help my child at school, I know and understand that:</p> <p>If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will notify school straight away and not send them to school. I will get them tested and I will let the school know the result. If it is a positive result, we will self-isolate for 14 days;</p> <p>If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child immediately. My child will be supervised by staff in the meeting room or another appropriate room until they are collected;</p> <p>On my way to and from school, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules, including waiting on the playground;</p> <p>My child must not bring any items into school unless previously arranged with the headteacher or class teacher and they will wear clean clothes every day;</p> <p>My child will have their temperature taken if they feel or present as being unwell;</p> <p>I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules and encourage my child to follow this wherever possible.</p> <p>My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;</p> <p>I will not be allowed into the school or entrance foyer without an appointment – please make appointments via telephone or email.</p> <p>There will be no access to toilet facilities for visitors or parents and carers;</p> <p>I will support all staff in their efforts to create an environment which is as safe as possible during this crisis;</p> <p>I will inform the school immediately of changes to any of my contact details;</p> <p>If my child or someone in our family household is high risk, they may be kept at home or sent home and can return to school once they can be safe.</p>	<p>I will do my best to:</p> <p>Keep to the social distancing rules in my bubble and in the playground;</p> <p>Tell an adult if I feel unwell;</p> <p>Not bring things into school from home except those which I know I am allowed;</p> <p>Only use the equipment provided to me by school and no other;</p> <p>Not mix with any other children from a different bubble in the school;</p> <p>Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate/door;</p> <p>Use good hygiene: coughing and sneezing into my elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);</p> <p>Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds and hand sanitizer when asked;</p> <p>Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;</p> <p>Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I may be sent home.
