AGGRESSIVE INCIDENTS – RESPECT

Sadly, since September we have experienced in school several aggressive incidents involving parents. Some of these have been against staff and some have been against other parents. Please be aware that as a school we **WILL NOT TOLERATE** any verbal or physical aggression against our staff or other parents. Swearing at staff will not be tolerated. We will contact the police to ensure **EVERY** incident has been logged. We will include details of the adults involved and details of what has happened. We will also fill out the council aggressive incident against staff form so they are aware of what has happened and who is involved. We will consider each incident as to whether or not we contact the BOROUGH SOLICITOR to take advice on managing the situation regarding whether or not we allow the aggressor back on the school site. The safety of our staff, children and families is of the UTMOST importance to us and we will do what we need to, to safeguard them. We will not allow our school reputation to be harmed due to a small minority. We ask EVERYONE to be respectful at all times when on site. Our children should not be hearing bad and foul language in general conversation.

SUPPORT

Please remember we are always here to listen should you encounter a problem. If your concern is about something that is happening in class or your child's learning please phone or e mail the school office to book a phone call or appointment to see your child's class teacher. If your child's class teacher is unable to help you can then contact the Band Leader or Assistant Headteacher for your child's key stage.

If you need to share more personal information about family circumstances or you need support such as uniform or food etc then ask the office staff if Miss Crampton or Mrs Parry are available.
